CAR SEAT DISTRIBUTION GUIDELINES

1. All Kaw Nation citizens are eligible for car seats, regardless of service area. All members of federally recognized tribes residing within Kay County, Oklahoma are eligible, with preference given to Kaw Nation citizens.
2. Car Seats will be given to children under 4'9" tall and weighing 80 pounds or less.
3. Child must have CDIB card and be an enrolled member of a federally recognized tribe. If the child does not have a CDIB card-, a copy of parent or caregiver's CDIB card and a copy of birth certificate of child can be accepted.
4. Parents, guardians, foster parents, and grandparents are eligible to receive a car seat. In cases of foster care or guardianship, copies of the legal document awarding custody or guardianship is required. In the event an applicant cannot present the application in person, applications may be sent via a third party. The third party will be required to sign a notarized statement indicating for whom they are receiving the car seat.
5. Only one car seat per child may be issued for each developmental stage of car seat. IE: Infant, Convertible, Combination, High Back Booster, Backless Booster.
6. Pregnant mothers will be eligible to apply following their 30th week of gestation.
