This 8 minute video was produced by KTWU for the Kansas Historical Society and was shown regularly and was available for purchase at the Kaw Mission State Historical Site in Council Grove. However the video was out of print and the Kaw Mission was out of stock so it was recently digitized and made available on KTWU's YouTube channel for educators to use in their classrooms.
